

Thursday, August 15, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.


A Special Called Meeting of the City Council of the City of West Lake Hills was held on the 15th day of August 2019 at 7:00 p.m., in the Council Chamber, Municipal Building, 911 Westlake Drive, West Lake Hills, Texas, for which proper notice was given.

1. With a quorum of the Councilmembers present, Mayor Linda Anthony called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. In attendance were: Mayor Linda Anthony; Councilmembers Mayor Pro Tem Jim O'Connor, Rhonda McCollough, Brian Plunkett, and Beth South. It was noted that Councilmember Darin Walker was not in attendance. Staff: Robert Wood, City Administrator.
2. Administration: Presentation of the preliminary concept for a proposed new city hall and police building and proposed bond election. Architect Denny Boles.
 - a. Staff Briefing. Mayor Anthony gave a brief historical review of the necessity for a new city hall and police building. Mr. Denny Boles presented the preliminary rendering for a proposed new city hall and police building along with information on a proposed bond election.
 - b. Public Hearing: Mayor Anthony opened the meeting for public comments. Mr. Gordon Bowman, Chair of the Bond Advisory Committee, spoke regarding the proposed bond election. He explained the role of the Committee and how the Committee will prepare a recommendation to Council. He did state that it is his preference to have a committee of 5 instead of 4.
 - c. Deliberation and action. There was discussion with no action taken.
3. Adjournment. Mayor Anthony adjourned the meeting at 8:40 p.m.
