Public Safety Report July 2019

Statistical Highlights

During the month of July, there were nine reported NIBRS part 1 offenses, compared with six for the month of June and six during the month of July last year. Officers made five in-custody or field release arrest in July for VCO – Cruelty to Animals, Assault with Injury Family Violence, Warrants, and Minor in Possession of Alcohol.

Officers responded to 20 Traffic Crashes, compared to 26 for June, and this resulted in 12 crash reports being created. Seven crashes this month occurred on Bee Cave Road.

In April, our officers made 424 traffic stops, resulting in 224 violations (53%), and 256 warnings (60%). Of the violations that were cited, 136 (60%) were for speeding, including 1 for speeding in a school zone. In the 15 targeted enforcement zones, we issued a total of 14 violations and 30 warnings.

During July, West Lake Hills Police Officers responded to 186, calls for service, compared to 181 calls for service in June. During the month, 52 reports were generated. Officers also conducted 151 close patrol checks for residents who were out of town, compared to 130 for June.

Investigations

In July, Detective Torres was assigned 19 new cases. Detective Torres currently has 43 active cases that she is investigating.

Training

Officers completed 66 hours of training, including classes in “Mental Health Officer”, “SFST Refresher”, “Ransomware” and “Micro USB Attack”.
