## Public Safety Report February, 2019

### **Statistical Highlights**

During the month of February, there were five reported NIBRS part 1 offenses, compared with eight for the month of January and two during the month of February last year. Officers made two in-custody or field release arrest in February for Driving while license invalid and Duty to give information and render aid.

Officers responded to 16 Traffic Crashes, compared to 11 for January, and this resulted in six crash reports being created. Six crashes this month occurred on Bee Cave Road.

In February, our officers made 244 traffic stops, resulting in 201 violations (82%), and 147 warnings (60%). Of the violations that were cited, 139 (56%) were for speeding, including 46 for speeding in a school zone. Officers also wrote two citations for failing to stop or remain stopped for a school bus. In the 15 targeted enforcement zones, we issued a total of 18 violations and 19 warnings.

During February, West Lake Hills Police Officers responded to 173 calls for service, compared to 207 calls for service in January. During the month, 24 reports were generated. Officers also conducted 75 close patrol checks for residents who were out of town, compared to 141 for December.

### **Investigations**

In February, Detective Torres was assigned 11 new cases. Of these 11 cases, three were closed or suspended in February – eight are carrying over into February. Detective Torres currently has 40 open cases that she is investigating.

### **Training**

Officers completed 120 hours of training, including classes in “Intermediate Collision Investigation” and “TCIC/NCIC Policy and Procedures”, along with Taser Recertification.
