

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST LAKE HILLS, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION, HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2021, TO DETERMINE WHETHER THERE SHALL BE A REPEAL OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF WEST LAKE HILLS, TEXAS, AT THE RATE OF ONE-HALF PERCENT (0.50%) FOR PROPERTY TAX RELIEF, AND AN ADOPTION OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF WEST LAKE HILLS, TEXAS, AT THE RATE OF ONE-HALF PERCENT (0.50%) TO PROVIDE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS; AND PROVIDING FOR THE FOLLOWING: FINDINGS OF FACT; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY; EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROPER NOTICE & MEETING.

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2021, the City Council ordered that a Special Election be held on the 2nd day of November, 2021, for the purpose of determining whether there shall be a repeal of the local sales and use tax in the City of West Lake Hills, Texas, at the rate of one-half percent (0.50%) for property tax relief, and an adoption of the local sales and use tax in the City of West Lake Hills, Texas, at the rate of one-half percent (0.50%) to provide for maintenance and repair of municipal streets; and

WHEREAS, on said election, the following proposition was submitted to the qualified voters of the City:

PROPOSITION C

The abolition of the one-half of one percent (0.50%) additional sales and use tax for property tax relief; and the adoption of the local sales and use tax in the City of West Lake Hills, Texas, at the rate of one-half percent (0.50%) to provide for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.

WHEREAS, this election was duly and legally held on November 2, 2021, in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of the election have been certified and returned by the proper judges and clerks; and

WHEREAS, upon consideration of the returns of said election, it appears that the same in all respects legally held, that notice was properly given, and that the returns thereof were duly and legally made; and it further appearing that there were cast at said special election for Proposition C a total of 771 votes which were cast as follows:

a local sales and use tax in the City of West Lake Hills, Texas, at the rate of one-half percent (0.50%) to provide for maintenance and repair of municipal streets, is hereby recognized and declared to have passed.

4. AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE

The Mayor of the City of West Lake Hills is authorized to execute, and the City Secretary is authorized to attest this Ordinance on behalf of the City Council. The Mayor is further authorized to do all other things legal and necessary in connection with the holding and consummation of the Election.

5. REPEALER

All ordinances, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

6. SEVERABILITY

Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Ordinance be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Ordinance.


7. EFFECTIVE DATE
