## Public Safety Report April, 2017

### **Investigations**

In April, Detective Torres was assigned 12 new cases. 7 of these cases were closed in April and 5 are carrying over into May. Detective Torres currently has 13 open cases that she is investigating.

### **Training**

Officers completed 105 hours of training, including classes in "Tactical Trauma Care", "Patrol Rifle", "Baton", "FEMA-ICS", "Crime Victims – Family Violence" and numerous "Computer Spam/Spoofing" awareness classes.

### **Statistical Highlights**

During the month of April, there were five reported Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) part 1 offenses, compared with two for the month of March and three during the month of April last year. Officers made three arrests during the month – two for Public Intoxication and one for Driving While Intoxicated.

Officers responded to 31 Traffic Collisions, compared to 25 for March. Our most common collision locations requiring police reports continue to be 3300-3600 Bee Cave Road and 5600 Bee Cave Road.

In April, our officers made 295 traffic stops, issuing 191 citations (69.4%) resulting in 207 violations, and 87 warnings (29.5%). Of the violations that were cited, 134 (64.7%) were for speeding, including 16 citations for Speeding in a School Zone. We also had eight citations issued for Failed to Stop for a School Bus and three for violation of the Hands-Free Ordinance. In the 14 targeted enforcement zones, we issued a total of 44 citations and 16 warnings.

During April, West Lake Hills Police Officers responded to 262 calls for service compared to 282 for March. This resulted in 26 reports being generated. Officers also conducted 122 close patrol checks for residents who were out of town, compared to 146 for March.
