## Public Safety Report October, 2018

### **Statistical Highlights**

During the month of October, there were 15 reported NIBRS part 1 offenses, compared with 13 for the month of September and nine during the month of October last year. Officers made three in-custody or field release arrests in October for Driving while License Invalid.

Officers responded to 23 Traffic Crashes, compared to 24 for September, and this resulted in five crash reports being created. Our most common crash location this month requiring a police report was Bee Cave Road, with three of our five crashes happening there.

In October, our officers made 140 traffic stops, issuing 104 citations (74.2%) resulting in 113 violations, and 86 warnings (61.4%). Of the violations that were cited, 77 (68.1%) were for speeding, including 27 for speeding in a school zone. Officers also wrote one citation for Failing to stop or remain stopped for a school bus. In the 15 targeted enforcement zones, we issued a total of 16 violations and 21 warnings.

During October, West Lake Hills Police Officers responded to 234 calls for service, compared to 265 calls for service in September. During the month, 45 reports were generated. Officers also conducted 137 close patrol checks for residents who were out of town, compared to 136 for September.

### **Investigations**

In October, Detective Torres was assigned 14 new cases. Of these 14 cases, seven were closed or suspended in October – seven are carrying over into November. Detective Torres currently has nine open cases that she is investigating.

### **Training**

Officers completed 148 hours of training, including classes in “Mental Health Officer”, “Field Training Officer”, Court Security Officer”, and multiple courses in “IT Security”.
